

# Finding Full Text Journal Articles

Go to the library's homepage:

[www.lib.utsa.edu](http://www.lib.utsa.edu)

Find print or microform text of articles

Find electronic text of articles



Use **UCAT**

Search by journal title.

Write down:

- \* Call number
  - \* Location
- For the year you need.

Use **E-Journal Locator** to see if UTSA Library subscribes electronically or has the full text in a database.

E-Journal will list any databases that contain the journal you searched for and tell you the dates that are available full text.

If you get no result

Use **Interlibrary Loan** to have the article delivered to UTSA. (Charges may apply. Allow at least two weeks for delivery).

Use **WorldCat** to see if any other library in town has the item. Check local school's catalog for currency. Go to that library to read or photocopy the article.

If you get no result

Use **E-Journal Locator** to see if UTSA Library subscribes electronically or has the full text in an online database.

Use **UCAT** and search by Journal Title to check print and microform holdings
